Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) of the IQAC (2011-12)

1. The students of Mariani College have been provided instructions regarding their curriculum and syllabus as when prescribed by the University. Mariani College authority has been maintain such an atmosphere in the College that the students have been studying in a disclined way, Health –awareness Programmes have been organized for the better and general welfare of the students. Two Associate Professor have been awarded PhD Fellowships by the U.G.C. while two Associate Professors have been awarded Ph.D Degrass. Another one has submitted her Ph.D thesis and awaiting for viva.
2. Semester System has been introduced in this College as directed by Dibrugarh University from this year under U.G.
3. As mentioned above, the curriculum and curricular design have been reformed in an innovative way, so as to cope with the world –wide demand in career opportunities and human values.
4. The college has been imparting education to the students in Arts, Commerce and Science Discipline s for a long time. I.C.T. has been inducted for the benefit of the students from the last year.
5. The Examination Reforms have been made as the College has been holding Examination in every sixth month now, in comparison to earlier conventional Yearly Examinations. Sessional Examination and Home-assignment have been introduced for the students; Internal Assessment has also been introduced.

7. The faculty members have been provided separate rooms.---
Department-wise for the smooth functioning of the various Departments. Every Department has been provided with a computer with Internet connection. The Women Cell of the college has been provided with a room.

16. The College often generates resources by way of receiving donations from N.G.Os and by offering its fields to alike –institutions and N.G.Os on hire for the just and humanitarian causes. (in off season).

18. The Women Cell of this College has been performing satisfactorily well in nearby villages providing Hand-pumps and organizing Health awareness Programmes among the villagers. The Cell also provided cloths to the flood affected people to Majuli, the famous and the biggest river island in the worlds.

20. The ratio of Teaching and Non Teaching staff is 41:13
21. The library has been computerized fully. The teachers and the students visit the Library frequently to acquire knowledge. The Library provides not only to the teachers and the students of this College, but also to the enthusiastic researchers also. The college authority has been constructing a multy-storied building for providing sufficient space for reading rooms for students as well as for the teachers.
22. The Library has been providing its reader’s one national daily and two other regional dailies; two national and other three regional languages –magazines. Besides these other Career – Oriented magazines have also been provided by the library.
23. The student assessment of teachers has been introduced in almost all the courses. The Colleges authority has been monitoring the system and actions have been taken expeditiously.
24. The feedback from the stakeholders will be initiated soon.
25. Unit cost of education will be forwarded later on.
26. The College has computerized all the Departments of Arts, Commerce and Science streams including the Library and the Office of the College. The process of admission, examination results and issues of certificate have been computerized.
27. The construction of the Auditorium has been completed and it has been utilized during the Youth Festival, Dibrugarh University. A building (R.C.C.) has been constructed for the girl-students as Common Room. The construction of a building attached to the Library has been going on for the reading facility of the students.
28. The college has been equipped with Audio- visual as well as C.C. Camera technology.
29. The college has provided computer and internet facilities to the teachers as well as non – teaching staff. The College has established a Computer Centre for imparting computer education to the students.
30. The college grants scholarships to the meritorious students as and when awarding financial aids to the poor students since 2009.
31. The Alumni Association has donated a big –sized concrete- constructed Notice Board in front of the college Library /Building. The Association has promised the College Authority to donate a considerable amount for constructing a class room for students.
32. The Parent- Teachers Association met twice and is has been planning to construct a class room in the college for benefit of the students.

33. An Eminent physician was invited as resource person to deliver a lecturer on “Diabetes – Precaution and Remedy” by the college authority. The Women Cell of the college also conducted such a “Health awareness Programmes” previously.
34. The performance regarding sport activities was not up to the mark in this year. However, the students took part in every of the Inter-college Competitions including Inter –college Cricket competition. The College has been providing every facility to the students in this regard.
35. This year, no incentives have been awarded to students due to their dismal performance in the Inter-college level sport activities. However, the winners of every event in the Annual sport that is held annually are rewarded every year.
36. The students who got 1st classes in the final T.D.C. Examination were felicitated with bouquets and books. The college authority provided financial assistances to those poor meritorious students who could not pursue higher studies despite their successful results in the last final exam.
37. The Career Guideline cell, Mariani College organized two Seminars and a workshop. The latter one was conducted for 15 days. Regarding counseling, experts from the prestigious institutions were invited to offer their counseling in I.C.T. I.C.A. (Institute of Computer Accountants) etc. A sizeable amount of books on career –based subjects were purchased for the benefit of the students. Career –related monthlies fortnightlies and a weekly are provided to the students.
38. The placement service to the students has been provided by way of organizing seminars/workshop and offering books and magazines in this regard.
39. The Development programme for non-teaching staff has been under consideration of the authority.
40. Only linkage which has been developed with national body is the U.G.C. Three Associate Professor attended international Seminars by this year.
41. Positive measures have been taken in completing the construction of Auditorium Last year, it was under construction. The Girls’ Hostel has been provided for residential purpose from this year. These two actions have been taken on the previous report.
42. A spacious room equipped with Table-Tennis Game –set has been provided to the students and another R.C.C. room has been provided to the girls; students of this College.

Section C: The College has progressed better than last year in terms of quality assurance of teachers, development regarding infrastructure –building and organizing National Seminars and Workshop. Above all the College has successfully organized Youth Festival –the cultural competitions of the students of the colleges under Dibrugarh University.
