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

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Report on 5th National Conference of NEICMA

The 5th National Conference of North East India Commerce and Management Association popularly known as NEICMA was organized this year by Mariani College, Mariani of Jorhat District, Assam on 23rd and 24th of September, 2022 after a gap of two long years because of the Covid pandemic all over the globe. The theme of the conference this time was a very relevant and a buzzing topic "Atmanirbhar Bharat: The Reclamation, Reformation and Resilience" and it was participated and attended by various stalwarts and doyens of commerce and management education as well as faculties and research scholars from different universities of North East India. The inaugural session was graced by some noted educationalist, Prof (Retd.) N B Dey from Assam University, Prof Debabrata Das, VC, ARGUCOM, Prof (Retd.) S. Sikidar of Gauhati University, Prof. (Retd.) Pranjal Bezborah of Dibrugarh University and President of NEICMA, Prof. G.P. Prasain, V.C., Tripura University as the distinguished guest and Dr. Kishor Goswami from IIT, Kharagpur as the keynote speaker. The MLA of Mariani, Rupjyoti Kurmi also graced the occasion with his visit during the session.
