The Social Science Forum of Mariani College has been formed by the three Departments, viz., Economics, History and Political Science, which come under the broad category of Social Sciences, as per the guidelines of the New Education Policy, 2020, of Dibrugarh University. The Forum is in its developing stage. The members of the Forum decided to begin the activities of the Forum by paying their heartfelt tribute to one of the most prominent personalities of Assam Kalaguru Bishnu Prasad Rabha on his 53rd death anniversary on 20th June, 2023.

The programme began by paying tribute to the Kalaguru by lightening lamps and incense sticks by the Principal of the College, followed by the teachers and the students.



After this, tribute was paid to Kalaguru Bishnu Prasad Rabha through his songs and poems by the faculty members and students of the College. In the beginning, the Principal, Dr. Horen Goowalla, gave a speech on the great works of Bishnu Prasad Rabha. He mentioned how the works of the Kalaguru still have impact on the Assamese society. One of the seniormost faculty members of the College, Dr. Bani Bora, Associate Professor, Department of Assamese, also gave her valuable speech on the occasion of Bishnu Rabha Divas. She also sang the Rabha Sangeet "Bishwar Chande Chande".



Another senior faculty member, Mr. Dhruvajyoti Neog, Associate Professor, Department of Economics also offered his valuable speech on the occasion. He also sang the Rabha sangeet "Poro Janamor Hubha Logonot".



Two other faculty members, Mrs. Archana Saikia, Assistant Professor, Department of Education, and Mrs. Nivedita Sarmah, Assistant Professor, Department of History sang Rabha Sangeet "Nahar Fule Nuhuai" and "Phoolkuworir Rokh Sumi loi Polai" respectively.
